GENERAL INFORMATION

Please read this leaflet carefully before you start using ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ medicine. This medicine is only available with a doctor's prescription. This document answers general questions. It does not contain all the available information.

All medicines have risks and benefits. Your doctor has weighed the risks of you using ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ against the benefits he or she expects it will have for you. If you have any concerns about using this medicine, please ask your doctor or pharmacist.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ is a medicinal cannabis product containing primarily tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) with small amounts of other cannabinoids.

ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ consists of dried cannabis flowers which have been grown under controlled conditions with GMP certification.

WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE

Each medicine is supplied as 10 grams of dried flower from the cannabis plant, in a plastic jar.

EACH ONE GRAM OF ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ CONTAINS:

Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) 260 mg
Other cannabinoids Less than 10 mg

WHAT IS ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ USED FOR?

Medicinal cannabis products containing tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) may have a role in some medical conditions including: intractable chronic pain, not sufficiently responsive to other analgesics; pain associated with spasticity in multiple sclerosis (MS); pain associated with cancer in palliative care; cancer treatment induced nausea and vomiting; appetite loss; insomnia; posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD); and abnormal muscle and body wasting.

The exact mechanism and magnitude of the effects of THC, is not fully understood. The THC in ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ acts on specific targets in the body, known as cannabinoid receptors. These receptors are found naturally throughout the body, in many tissues and organs, but they are especially numerous in the brain and nervous system.

The potential benefits as well as the unwanted effects associated with medicinal cannabis use may vary between individuals, and depending on the amount and type of medicinal cannabis used. Your doctor will assess the suitability and dose of the ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ for your clinical condition.

BEFORE YOU TAKE ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ

DO NOT USE ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ IF:

- You are allergic to cannabis.
- You are pregnant, are planning to get pregnant, or you are breastfeeding.
- You have a personal history of schizophrenia or psychosis.
- You are under 18 years of age.

TELL YOUR DOCTOR BEFORE USING ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ IF:

- you have liver, kidney, heart, or lung problems.
- you have epilepsy or recurrent seizures.
- you have a family history of serious mental disorders such as schizophrenia, psychosis, depression, or bipolar disorder.
- you have a history of alcohol or drug abuse or substance dependence.

DO NOT TAKE ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ AFTER THE EXPIRY DATE HAS PASSED.

DO NOT TAKE ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ IF THE PACKAGING IS DAMAGED OR BEEN TAMPERED WITH.

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE WHETHER YOU SHOULD START TAKING ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR DOCTOR OR PHARMACIST.

TAKING ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ WITH OTHER MEDICINES

Some medicines may interact with ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ.

These include any drugs which slow down the central nervous system, causing drowsiness. These may include sleeping pills, sedatives, some pain medicines, some allergy or cold medicines, anti-seizure medicines or alcohol.

Other drugs that may interfere with ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ include antiretroviral drugs used in the treatment of HIV/AIDS, some anti-depressants, stomach acid inhibitors, some antibiotic and antifungal medicines, certain heart medicines and Saint John's Wort.

These medicines may be affected by ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ or may affect how well it works. You may need different amounts of your medicine, or you may need to take different medicines. Your doctor or pharmacist has more information on medicines to be careful with or avoid while taking ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ.

HOW TO TAKE ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ

HOW AND WHEN TO TAKE IT

Your doctor will advise you on the most appropriate way to take ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ.

There is not yet a scientifically defined dose of medicinal cannabis for many medical conditions. Your doctor will work with you to decide the dose of ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ that best suits you and your condition. If you have not consumed medicinal cannabis before, it would be prudent to have someone with you the first time you use it.

Follow all directions given to you by your doctor and pharmacist. Your doctor will guide you on how to start with a very low dose and gradually increase the dose using the approach of "Start Low, Go Slow". You and your doctor will monitor the medicine's effectiveness and any unwanted effects. Your doctor will advise you how long you should keep taking ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ for.

IF YOU FORGET TO TAKE IT

Wait until the next dose is due. Do not take a double dose to make up for the dose that you missed. This may increase the risk of getting unwanted effects.

THINGS YOU MUST DO

Stop using ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ immediately and consult your doctor if you begin to experience any severe side effects (see section SIDE EFFECTS).

If you are about to be started on any other new medicine, tell your doctor and pharmacist that you are taking ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ.

THINGS YOU MUST NOT DO

Do not give ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ may make you feel differently than usual and slow your coordination, reaction times and motor skills.

DO NOT DRIVE OR OPERATE HEAVY OR DANGEROUS MACHINERY WHILE TAKING ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ.

THINGS TO BE CAREFUL OF

ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ may make you feel differently than usual. Discuss these aspects and any potential impacts on your daily activities.

IF YOU TAKE TOO MUCH (OVERDOSE)

If you think that you may have taken too much ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ, immediately telephone your doctor or the Poisons Information Centre on 13 11 26 or go to the Emergency Department at your nearest hospital.

Do this even if there are no signs or symptoms of discomfort or poisoning.

Symptoms of overdose may include excessive sleepiness, confusion, disorientation, clumsiness or loss of coordination, fainting, dizziness, chest pain, fast, slow, or pounding heartbeat, panic attacks, loss of contact with reality and seizures.

SIDE EFFECTS

Tell your doctor or pharmacist as soon as possible if you start to feel unwell after using ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ. All medicines can have side effects. Sometimes they are serious, most of the time they are not. You may need medical treatment if you experience severe side effects. Do not be alarmed by this list of possible side effects. You may not experience any of them.

SOME OF THE KNOWN SIDE EFFECTS OF MEDICINAL CANNABIS ARE:

- Phlegm and cough
- Dizziness, drowsiness, feeling faint or lightheaded
- Feeling tired feeling sick, vomiting, or diarrhoea
- Blurred vision
- Appetite changes
- Fast heartbeat
- Hallucinations or hearing voices

Other side effects not listed above may also occur in some patients. Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you notice any unwanted effects and they can advise you on how to manage them.

PRODUCT HANDLING

STORAGE

Store below 25°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL

Return any unused or expired ALL NATIONS LEMON TARTZ to a pharmacy for safe disposal.

EXPIRY

Refer to the expiry date shown on the jar label.
